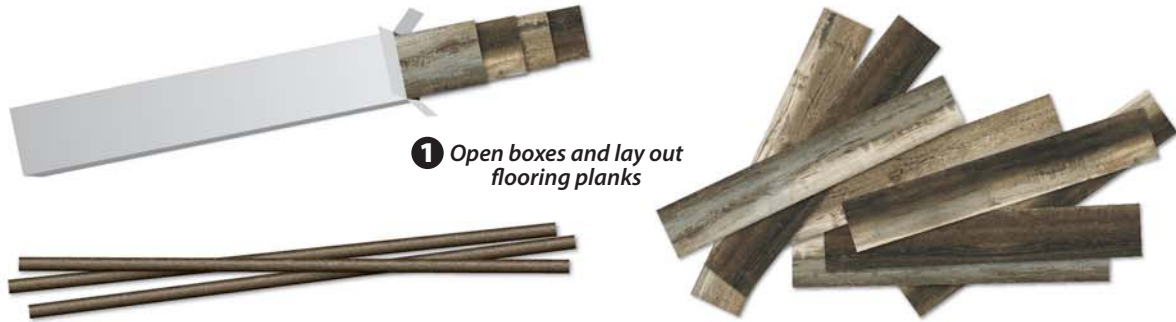


There are many ways to blend floors with your moldings to ensure a seamless transition and a polished, designer look.

Open the boxes of flooring and the trims you will need for the entire install area.



Put the planks together with different intensities of the same color. Then, pair them with the trims in the area they will be installed. Choose whichever flooring plank that is closest in color and grain of the trim.

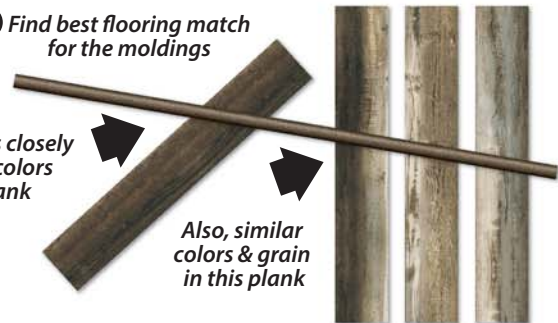
2 Group planks of similar color & grain



3 Find best flooring match for the moldings

The moldings closely match the colors in this plank

Also, similar colors & grain in this plank



When installing the floor, place the planks that closely match the moldings towards the outer edge, where the moldings will be added later

4 Place flooring next molding of similar colors and grain

Even though the match may not be exact, once furniture, area rugs and accessories are added to the space, the slight difference between the floor and trims will be minimized and your trims will fade into the entire space.

Once rugs & furniture are in place, the floor and moldings will blend nicely together
